Dear friends,

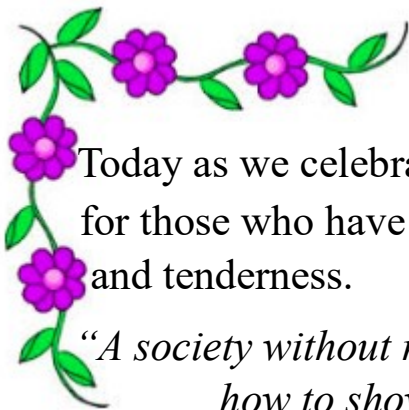

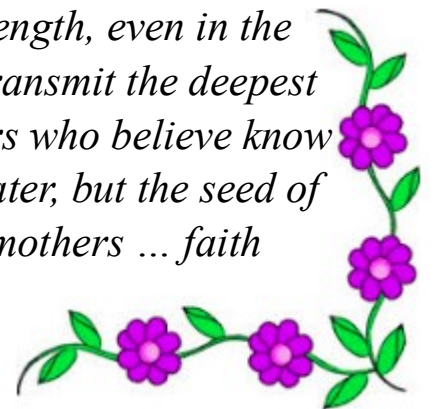
