In November we have the opportunity to deepen our faith in the Communion of Saintsour friends in Heaven. "The best thing about the communion of saints is that it connects us all—because we are one body. When we celebrate the Eucharist, we pray with all those who have gone before us. We living can pray for the dead, for those who need prayers on their journey to God. The multitude in heaven pray for the rest of us, inspire us by their example, and remain present to us in ways of which we know not. "I will spend my heaven doing good on earth," said St. Thérèse of Lisieux before her death. So we are bound, in some marvellous, inexplicable way, to those who've gone before us. Code of Conduct

After our Liturgy this morning we will once again sign the code of conduct form which is valid for three years.

"The Child Protection Code of Conduct informs and reminds all employees and volunteers of the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn of the standards of behaviour as well as other requirements that must be adhered to when working with children.

All clergy, employees and volunteers within Archdiocesan parishes, regardless of whether they work with children, are required to sign the declaration to the Code. The declaration is to be signed every three years and given to the local parish office staff. The implementation of this Code of Conduct is a reminder that our children are a gift from God. They are valued and are to be loved, respected and cared for in a manner that meets both the teachings of the Gospel and the expectations of our community."
