## Updated Protocols—Effective Monday 7 December 2020

- Apply the 2m<sup>2</sup> rule for all liturgical celebrations—our church can accommodate 100 worshippers
- 2. Physical or digital Mass Register to be kept for 30 days
- Availability of hand sanitiser is essential 3.
- Holy Communion only under the species of bread 4.
- 5. Holy Communion to be received only in the hand
- No touching at the sign of peace 6.
- Collection plates not to be passed around 7.
- 8. Families can sit together, but in relation to other persons/families apply 2m<sup>2</sup> rule
- 9. Singing is possible, respecting 2m<sup>2</sup> rule, people facing the same direction.

### Pope Proclaims Year of St Joseph

Pope Francis has declared a Year of St Joseph in honour of the 150th anniversary of the saint's proclamation as patron of the Universal Church. "Each of us can discover in Joseph – the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence – an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble," he wrote. "St Joseph reminds us that those who appear hidden or in the shadows can play an incomparable role in the history of salvation." Pope Pius IX proclaimed St Joseph patron of the Universal Church on December 8, 1870, in the decree Quemadmodum Deus.

### **An Advent Reflection**

"In the Christmas mystery, the God of love becomes one of us so that we might become one with God. But the Incarnation is not only an event but a practice: that we "embody" the love of God for the sake of others. May this Christmas be the beginning of our own "practice" of Incarnation: to leave our own selfcentred world to travel, with humility and peace, the road trod by those in need and, through our patience, understanding and generosity, reveal the light of God's compassion and mercy illuminating that road."
