For your interest: In some parts of the world because of the pandemic the priest will address all worshippers once when saying, "Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return," or a similar phrase. Traditionally the priest repeats this phrase to each person. The second change is that the priest will not put the ashes on the forehead but will let them fall on each person's head, without saying anything.
