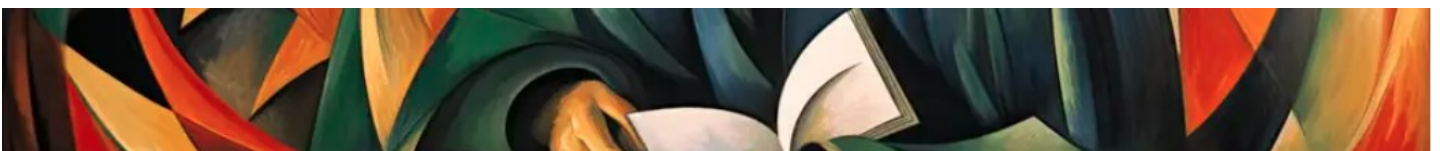

We have taken for granted plentiful rain and the importance of abundant harvests.

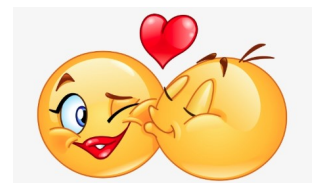
Please forgive us.
