Falling in Love with God

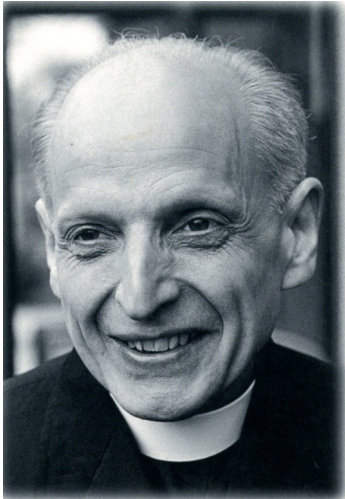
