#### **Plenary Council Update**

The National Centre for Pastoral Research is currently conducting the in-depth analysis of the 17,457 submissions -- representing more than 222,000 people -- which were received during the Listening and Dialogue stage. People in every corner of Australia and from various parts of the Catholic Church -- and beyond -- participated in the Listening and Dialogue phase of the Plenary Council, a new report shows. The **National Themes for Discernment** will be announced on June 9 -- Pentecost Sunday. Some of the largest groups to participate in the Listening and Dialogue phase included Catholic Social Services Victoria, a large parish in Canberra's growing northern suburbs and the Passionist Family Movement. The top five countries of birth for respondents, after Australia, were the United Kingdom, the Philippines, New Zealand, India and Ireland. Half of the individual submissions received came from women, while 29 per cent came from men.
