Plenary Council

A Plenary Council is the highest formal gathering of all local churches in a country. Fr Brian McCoy SJ, Provincial of the Jesuits writes, "There are good reasons why some might question how a clear, strong voice can or will be heard in the Australian Church in the coming years. This is only the fifth such Australian Plenary Council. We clearly have much to learn about listening to the voice of the laity, about developing structures of governance that are inclusive, and about being more open and transparent. Can sensitive points be raised and put on the table for further discussion? Can we be people who deeply listen and discern how the Holy Spirit is guiding us at this time? I believe and hope we can."

Pope Francis—Call to Holiness

Earlier this year Pope Francis released his exhortation on the call to holiness. In this excerpt he reminds us of: Our Mission in Christ

19. A Christian cannot think of his or her mission on earth without seeing it as a path of holiness, for "this is the will of God, your sanctification" (1 Thess 4:3). Each saint is a mission, planned by the Father to reflect and embody, at a specific moment in history, a certain aspect of the Gospel.

20. That mission has its fullest meaning in Christ, and can only be understood through him. At its core, holiness is experiencing, in union with Christ, the mysteries of his life. It consists in uniting ourselves to the Lord's death and resurrection in a unique and personal way, constantly dying and rising anew with him. But it can also entail reproducing in our own lives various aspects of Jesus' earthly life: his hidden life, his life in community, his closeness to the outcast, his poverty and other ways in which he showed his self-sacrificing love. ... "Christ enables us to live in him all that he himself lived, and he lives it in us".

2018 Good Friday Collection for the Holy Land
