Reflection

Towards the end of her life Mary MacKillop sent to the sisters a reflection on her own spiritual experience in the form on "An appeal of the Sacred Heart to a Weary, Disappointed Soul". In it she reveals that it was the tender, loving Heart of Jesus that spoke to her and brought her to such peace and joy in his service. She concluded her reflection: "And with this burning appeal came such a longing desire on my part to be Its lover and own true child that, in a glance, the falseness of the world appeared to me. The beauty, the pity, and the generosity of the Sacred Heart in this loving appeal could not be resisted. And in It, I have never known aught but true peace and contentment of heart. Its love makes suffering sweet; Its love makes the world a desert. When storms rage, when persecutions or dangers threaten, I quietly creep into Its abyss, and securely sheltered there, my soul is in peace, though my body is tossed upon the stormy waves of a cold and selfish world.
