Both gatherings can be influential for the Church. A Plenary Council is the highest form of gathering of local church and has legislative and governance authority. The decisions that are made at the Council become binding for the Catholic Church in Australia. A Synod does not have this legislative and governance authority.

Social Justice Statement

A Place to Call Home: Making a home for Everyone in Our Land. We celebrate Social Justice Sunday on 30th September. This year, the Catholic Bishop's Social Justice Statement is titled "A Place to Call Home: Making a Home for Everyone in Our Land". It is a response to the growing problem of homelessness in Australia and a challenge to each of us to confront Australia's growing rate of homelessness and unaffordable housing. The Statement confronts the growing challenge of homelessness and housing insecurity in Australia, where, according to the latest census figures, there are some 116,000 homeless people in Australia. The statement examines the extent and causes of Australia's homelessness and housing crisis. It emphasises that secure housing is a human right and an uncontestable public good, affirmed by both Catholic teaching and the Declaration of Human Rights. It issues a challenge to government, to Church and community and to us as individuals to bring about change and reform. The Statement will be launched in September and will be available on the Australian Catholic Social Justice Council (ACSJC) website (www.socialjustice.catholic.org.au).
