**Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Pope Francis has established that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God.

The newly established **"Sunday of the Word of God"** is an invitation to Catholics across the world to deepen their appreciation, love and faithful witness to God and his word, Pope Francis said. In his letter, Francis wrote, "A day devoted to the Bible should not be seen as a yearly event but rather a yearlong event, for we urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers." ... "We need to develop a closer relationship with sacred Scripture; otherwise, our hearts will remain cold and our eyes shut, struck as we are by so many forms of blindness," he wrote.

**Plenary Council**

We continue to seek the wisdom of Holy Spirit as we focus on the six themes identified by the first phase of prayer and listening. These themes invite people to consider *‘How is God calling us to be a Christ-centred Church in Australia’*.
