Ritual of Remembrance

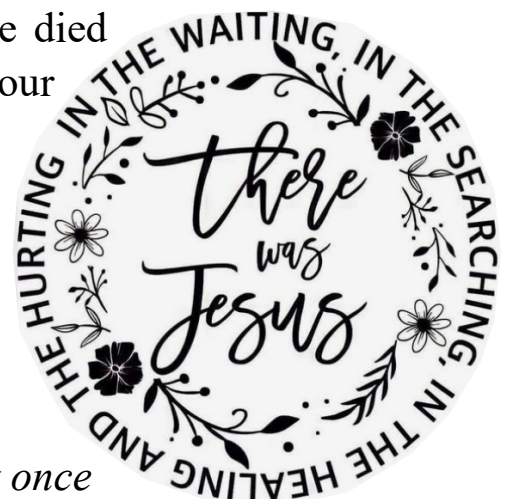
Today we remember in a special way those who have died during the year, especially the recently deceased and our deceased families and friends:
