



Love & Law.

At the centre of the discussion between Jesus and the lawyer is a law that requires 'love'. We might ask: how can 'love' be





enjoin on you today, that you may live and increase'. Jesus echoes this command when he says to the lawyer, 'Do this and life is yours'.

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

It was a standard feature of ancient covenants that the one imposing the stipulations would command his servant to love him. The subjects of the Assyrian king Assurbanipal are commanded, 'You will love Assurbanipal as yourselves'; in another text the subjects reply, '... the king of Assyria, our lord, we will love'. In

these contexts 'love' means loyalty; in turn, loyalty is expressed in obedience. This kind of 'love' can be legislated for it requires a certain kind of behaviour, not an emotional response of affection towards another. The connection between 'love' and 'obedience' is clearly in Jesus' mind when he says, 'If you love me, you will keep my commandments'. Love is not an emotion; it is something one does: 'what must I do?', 'do this and life is yours', 'go and do the same yourself'.

Discipleship: sitting at his feet The Lectionary omits the first half of verse 38: 'As they continued on the journey ...' On Sunday 13 we discussed



the journey as a metaphor for discipleship, i.e, following Jesus, even to Jerusalem. This Sunday's episode in the gospel highlights another aspect of discipleship. Mary 'sat down at the Lord's feet and listened to him speaking'. The Greek here is more specific: Mary 'listened to his word'. Luke has earlier implied that the word of Jesus is comparable to the word of God, Mary, then, is listening to 'his word' Moreover, Mary's posture indicates what is happening in this scene. 'To sit at the feet' is the posture of a disciple. In Acts 22:3, Paul explains his rigorous Jewish background: 'At the feet of Gamaliel I was educated strictly in our ancestral law'. Any action at the feet of another recognises the authority of that person. Disciples are those who are silent and listen to a Master; the Master instructs, the disciple learns.



In a patriarchal society it is very unusual for a woman to be in the place of a disciple. Yet Mary has presumed to take this traditionally male place and Jesus, in violation of expected custom, not only accepts her but declares that she has chosen the better part. In this Mary models for disciples the essential attitude of attentiveness: 'blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it.' Not only do those who are instructed by his word become disciples, they are his family: 'My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and act on it'.

Martha acknowledges Jesus as the Master by addressing him as 'Lord'. But then she presumes to give him instructions, 'Tell her to help me'! In her eagerness to serve at table she has neglected his word - something the apostles will explicitly refuse to do. To follow Jesus, disciples must listen 'at his feet'.
