Acknowledging the suffering of Sexual abuse victims is paramount. May we 'rejoice in our own sufferings' and join with theirs to 'make up what is lacking' from the Church (Col. 1:24). We pray for the grace to cry with them.



We as a Church community are also suffering. We are feeling vulnerable, injustice and shame, while trying to comprehend the unbelievable- we can all expect to have to answer the question "Why are you still Catholic?" by a media and society more and more unable to comprehend the Church's continuing existence and place in Australian society. These emotions and experiences unite us all (no matter how we might personally view the outcome of the Cardinal Pell trial).

I invite people to gather with me next week (back of Church) after each Ash Wednesday Mass (Mass times: Tathra 9am- Bega 12:15, 5:30pm). We will begin with a prayer for the victims of sexual abuse. Afterwards we will share our answers to the question "Why I am still Catholic".
