

Luke begins his gospel with a formal introduction that describes his work and the work of others who preceded



Luke's Gentile readers face a different but related problem: as Christianity loses ground in the Jewish world and increasingly moves into Gentile territory, it could easily be assumed that God has abandoned the Jews and has newly adopted the Gentiles. (Paul had to argue against this view in his letter to the Romans.) If this were the case, Gentiles might fear that God would also abandon them in the future. Luke goes to great lengths to show that God's plan is orderly: the offer of salvation began with Jews and when God had fulfilled the divine promises to them, God extended



salvation to include Gentiles. Thus, Gentiles can be assured that Jesus' offer of salvation is trustworthy and is a continuation of the divine mercy that began with the Jewish ancestors, 'Abraham and his descendants'.

In like manner, the words of Jesus in this gospel are trustworthy. Being forewarned, disciples can stand with confident assurance because the coming of the Son of Man is not disaster, but rather is the dawn of their redemption.
