In the gospel Jesus is 'the living bread that came down from heaven', a bread that gives eternal life to those who eat it. As Jesus explains, the heavenly bread is his flesh. In John's gospel Jesus is also the Word of God; in turn, the Word became flesh and gives life. Indeed, the Word is the source of life. In John's gospel both heavenly bread and word are revealed in the flesh of Christ; both bread and word give life. Under both aspects Jesus gives himself for one purpose: 'for the life of the world'. The self-giving of the Word is accomplished in the incarnation; the self-giving of the bread/flesh is accomplished upon the cross.
