



Christ as King

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE A

The parables of the previous two Sundays discussed the return of

Daniel's mysterious and glorious Son of Man is Jesus.





The scope and character of Jesus' glorious reign are unlike the reign of other earthly kings. First, his rule, and hence his judgment, is over 'all the nations.' Even the greatest superpower of the day, the Roman Empire, was not so far reaching. Second, the kings of the earth demand from their subjects loyalty and taxes; some kingdoms require military service. Christ the King demands care for 'the least of my brothers.' Though all the brothers and sisters of Jesus are members of his royal family, some are without food and drink, others are naked and imprisoned. Jesus accounts care of them as care of him. This is not a new teaching. Earlier, Jesus had instructed his disciples as he sent them out on mission: 'Whoever receives you receives me' (Sunday 13).

This presentation of Jesus, and the identification of Jesus with his 'least ones,' has profound implications for ethical conduct. This is not merely a story of 'doing good,' a religious warrant for secular humanitarian action. Service of others is service of Jesus; service of Jesus is recognition of his sovereignty. Christ is King.
