



28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Let us suppose that you are giving a party. When you have fixed the date,



Some accept your invitation. Every acceptance makes you feel happy. Of course there can be degrees of acceptance. Some may accept half-heartedly; they are coming only because they feel in some way obliged to come. But others may accept with enthusiasm; they feel honoured and grateful for having been invited.



Others refuse your invitation. Every refusal disappoints you, perhaps even hurts you, but at least you know where you stand with these people. There can also be degrees of refusal. In some cases if may be that people would like to come but can't because they have a prior engagement on the date in question. But in other cases people are just not interested; it's not that they can't come but that they won't come.

There is a third way of responding to the invitation - by not responding at all. Yes, that too is a response. You wait and wait for a reply but none comes. This is the worst kind of response of all.

God doesn't compel us. He invites us.

To ignore God's invitation altogether is the worst form of refusal. It implies indifference. Indifferent people are the hardest to convert.

PRAYERS Hugo D'Arcy and his family Noah Smith - operation in Sydney

15th - St Teresa of Jesus, Virgin & Doctor of the Church 1515-1582. Remembered as a strong, practical reformer who restored the strict Carmelite observance of poverty, solitude, and austerity.

16th - St Margaret Mary Alacoque, Virgin 1647-1690. Remembered especially for persevering in promoting devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. S

16th - St Hedwig, Religious 1174-1243. Remembered for founding religious houses & hospitals, for her charity to the poor, and for her efforts at peacemaking. 17th - St Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop & Martyr died 107. Remembered for seven letters written on his way to execution. They show him to be devoted to Christ and his resurrection; they urge Christians to unity in and through the Eucharist and around their local bishop. Called himself the "God-bearer." 18th - St Luke, Evangelist.

19th - St Paul of the Cross, Priest 1694-1775. Remembered for his prophetic easts preaching in parish missions, for calling sinners to repentance, and for his special

gifts of healing

19th - St John de Brebeuf (1593-1649) & St Isaac Jogues (1607-1646), Priests, & Companions, Marytrs. Remembered for the hardship they suffered for the sake of the gospel, eventually embracing even torture and death
