



as we hear in Acts of the Apostles, but on the evening of Easter Sunday itself. While the various texts of the New Testament may not agree on their chronology, they do agree on the important point about the significance and purpose of the Spirit being given.

Augustine of Hippo expressed this significance well in one of his homilies preached to his congregation in the early years of the fifth century about how the disunity symbolised by the tower of Babel was reversed by the conferring of the Spirit:

At Pentecost, by contrast, the humble piety of believers brought all these diverse languages into the unity of the church. What discord had scattered, love was to gather together. Like the limbs of a single body, the separated members of the human race would be restored to unity by being joined to Christ, their common head, and welded into the oneness of a holy body by the fire of love. Anyone therefore who rejects the gift of peace and withdraws from the fellowship of this unity cuts himself off from the gift of the Holy Spirit. (Sermo 271)

PRAYERS Hugo D'Arcy and his family

29th May - St Paul VI, pope (1963-1978), 1897-1978. He brought the Second Vatican Council to its completion. Established the Synod of Bishops as advisory body to the papacy.

31st - The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It was introduced into the Franciscan calendar by St Bonaventure in the thirteenth century and was extended in 1389 to the entire Latin Church to heal the divisions in the Western Church of the time.

1st June - St Justin, Martyr. 100-165. Remembered for his reasoned defence of Christian belief and practice and for the ultimate witness given by his martyrdom. 2nd - St Marcellinus & St Peter, Martyrs, died 304. Reputedly members of the Roman clergy. Remembered with special honour in the Church of Rome, evident in the basilica built over their tombs and their mention in Eucharistic Prayer I. 3rd - St Charles Lwanga & companions, Martyred between 1885 and 1887, these 22 martyrs were among many newly baptised Catholics and Anglicans who were killed for their faith and virtue in Uganda by a debauched and brutal ruler. Remembered for the heroic calm of their fidelity to Christ.

Front page Cont. Acts of the Apostles shows us how the earliest Christians attempted to live this unity: it was a unity in diversity, not a unity based on uniformity. Theirs was a unity based on a common experience of the love, forgiveness, and peace of Jesus. In a fractured world, we, as Christian people, must be living beacons of unity. We know we have the Spirit when our actions lead to reconciliation, not division; when they lead to understanding, not anger; when they lead to hope, not despair. We are thankful today for the gift of the Spirit, who inflames our hearts and makes us one.
