Reflection on today's readings:

Today's readings have some of the messianic joy that Jesus brings to all people, especially the poor.

The First Reading, from the prophet Isaiah, is full of hope and joy. He looks forward to deliverance from exile; people will be healed, creation revived with gushing water.

In response, Psalm 146 is a prayer of praise to the God who feeds the hungry, heals the sick, and cares for the poor and downtrodden.

St James, in the Second Reading, clearly states that God chooses the poor, and that we too must not favour the rich and powerful at their expense. We are all equal in God's sight and must act accordingly. We are all heirs to his kingdom.

The Gospel recounts the healing of the deaf man with an impediment in his speech. His healing is not just physical; the whole person is opened to the Lord.

Let us try to spread some of the joy of Jesus around us this week. Perhaps in this way we can become more aware of any hidden prejudices we may hold in our relationships to others.



The Australian Catholic Church marks Child Safeguarding Sunday this week. It concludes National Child Protection Week.

Uniquely this year Child Protection Sunday follows on the heels of the formal response of the Australian Catholic Church to the recommendations of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse and the release of the advice provided to Church Leaders by its Truth Justice and Healing Council.

When the Australian Prime Minister offers the response of the Commonwealth Government in Parliament on 22 October we pray it may bring a further sense of how we, both as a Church and as a Nation, have faced the terrible truth that we failed our children, but also as a church and as a nation, we have now embarked on a new path.
