
Gospel Acclamation:

Reflection on the Gospel:

There is no Christianity without a cross. And if we want to follow, we have to take up the cross. That's the hard truth. We take up the cross when we choose sacrifice we could avoid in order to help others

Taking up the cross means giving up your life each day in little ways. You take up your cross when you help someone without having to be asked. You take up your cross when you reach out to the unpopular kid in the yard. You take up your cross when you sacrifice time with friends for time at the soup kitchen or homeless shelter.

Like Peter, each day we must decide who we think Jesus is. We show that he is our Messiah (the one who came to save us) when we choose to sacrifice for others. Oddly enough, it is through those little sacrifices that we really save our own lives – and add to the lives of others.

An outreach to the poor

Kate Cleary has been door knocking among the poor in Canberra for 6 years. Her work is mainly on public housing complexes but she also visits the jail and the brothels. Over this time, she discovered among the people she was meeting many mothers who were unable to care for their children because of drug use and domestic violence. She believed these women could bring up their children if they were given support at vulnerable times in their lives. As a result, she is now in the process of setting up a facility to house women and children at risk of separation due to severe social deprivation.

She will talk briefly at Mass next week about the new needs she sees and about an upcoming seminar in Canberra looking at how the average person can help the people like those she is coming into contact with: how we can be like the Good Samaritan to those around us in these dark and difficult times.
