Let us reflect:

Before the church lies a mission to bring justice and healing to survivors of abuse, according to Archbishop Mark Coleridge.

Delivering the homily at the final Mass of the Vatican Summit on the Protection of Minors in Rome on the weekend, Archbishop Coleridge said this mission demanded concrete action, not just words.

'We will do all we can to bring justice and healing to survivors of abuse; we will listen to them, believe them and walk with them; we will ensure that those who have abused are never again able to offend; we will call to account those who have concealed abuse; we will strengthen the processes of recruitment and formation of Church leaders; we will educate all our people in what safeguarding requires; we will do all in our power to make sure that the horrors of the past are not repeated and that the Church is a safe place for all; a loving mother especially for the young and the vulnerable; we will not act alone but will work with all concerned for the good of the young and the vulnerable; we will continue to deepen our own understanding of abuse and its effects, of why it has happened in the Church and what must be done to eradicate it.

'All of this will take time, but we do not have forever, and we dare not fail.'

In his closing talk to the Summit, Pope Francis committed the church to do everything possible to eradicate sexual abuse from within the church and from society as a whole. And while the summit has ended, the work to ensure laws and concrete actions are in place is just beginning, Fr Frederico Lombardi said.
