### **Grounded in Truth, Walk Together with Courage – Queanbeyan-Palerang Reconciliation Walk 2019**

Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council invites members of the community to join together and mark National Reconciliation Week by walking together through Queanbeyan in unity.

At the heart of reconciliation is the relationship between the broader Australian community and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. This year's theme is "Grounded in Truth, Walk Together with Courage". The theme emphasises the truthful representation of Australia's colonial past and the strengthening of respectful relationships as we move forward into the future.

Our youth will proudly represent their school and community on this important day.

"This year our aim is to provide the community with a cultural experience," said Tina Brown, Aboriginal Projects and Liaison Officer, Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council.

All are welcome to this FREE event which will include cultural activities at the end of the walk and the official proceedings.

In previous years more than 1,000 people have attended the walk and with parents and grandparents joining their children, support from

Queanbeyan businesses and with more schools coming on board numbers are expected to grow even further.
