### **The Word of the Lord**

From the 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> August, you will notice a change in the way the readings from the Bible are done. There will be a period of silence after the first reading before the Psalm, a period of silence after the Psalm and a period of silence after the second reading before the Gospel Acclamation.

The silence is to allow you some moments to contemplate what has been read, you may like to pick out a word or a phrase from the reading that has some particular meaning for you. You may like to apply the reading to some challenge you are facing in life. Or, simply, to allow the reading to take root in your heart.

The Gospel Acclamation verse printed on the Bulletin sheets will also be used from that date. We will sing the alleluias, speak the verse and sing the alleluias again.

The readers and commentators have been briefed on the changes.
