Pope Francis – On the Call to Holiness in Today's World

Yes, the humblest members of our community are often the ones whom God chooses to be a model for us all. As Vatican II taught in Chapter Twelve of the great Constitution on the Church, all the baptised share in the prophetic work of witnessing to God's love.

They touch our lives in ways we don't always see or understand. Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (killed by the Nazis in Auschwitz in 1942) reminds us that we may not know until we are in the light of heaven about all those whose loving touch formed and shaped us.

All Christians experience this call to holiness, and people also experience it beyond the Christian faith as God works in mysterious ways. Holiness is the most attractive face of the Church because when men and women sacrifice themselves on behalf of others, it is compelling.

Adaminaby Listening Session for Plenary Council

Two very important things came out of this Listening Session. The first was that the Church has to be inclusive, it must be as Jesus was, welcoming to all. And the second very interesting suggestion was that in Australia there needs to be a national body of lay Catholics that can liaise with the Australian Bishops Conference.

Cooma Parish Pastoral Council

In the Cooma Listening Session for the Plenary Council there were suggestions made regarding Parish Pastoral Councils. In the past, the emphasis in regard to Parish Councils was that they were the main consultative bodies for the Parish Priest to be able to receive advice for carrying out his work. The suggestions coming from the Listening Sessions seems to be asking for Parish Councils to have more of a voice in the management of the Parish. We will have to see if other Listening Sessions around the country also see it this way. But we don't have to wait for the Plenary Council to decide on how we structure our Parish Council. In the coming months the present Parish Council will discuss ways of making ours more effective in communication with the Parish and involving all Parishioners.
