Pope Francis: On the Call to be Holy

Be open to God in whatever situation you find yourself in life. Remember, you have the power of the Spirit within you who gives you all the strength and courage you need for this. Also, you have the Church and, in the Church, you have the guiding hand of God through Scripture, liturgy, holy places, and a whole crowd of saints.

The kind of holiness I'm describing here is lived in small ways most of the time. For example, you go shopping and meet a neighbour, you avoid gossip. Later, your children need you, you give them the time even if you are tired. When you feel anxious, you pray. Later, you meet a homeless person, you stop and say a kind word to him or her. Each moment is a step toward holiness. We live this holiness in the particular situation in which we find ourselves each day.
