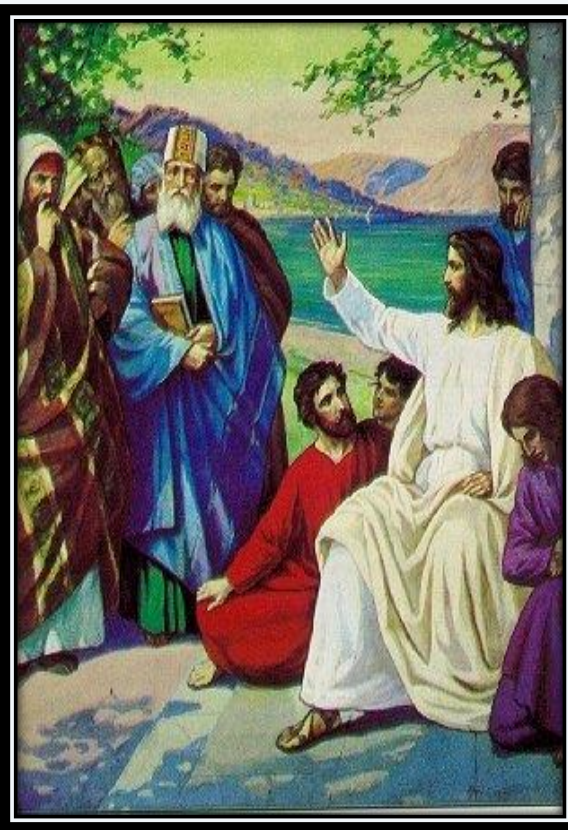

Contemporary Gnosticism- GNOSTICISM is concerned with a set of theories or ideas, with knowing about God but not necessarily walking with God and experiencing God's love. We cannot separate the mystery of our faith from the body of Christ.
