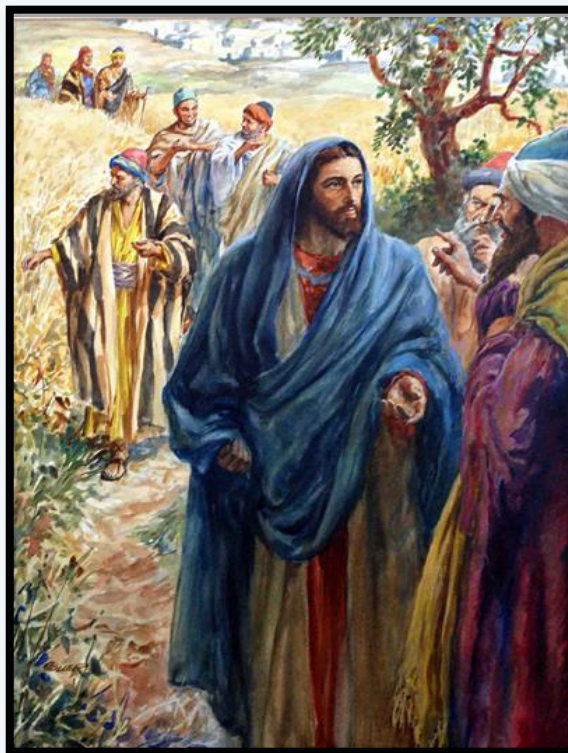

Almsgiving is the third discipline for Lent. In the earliest days of the Church, charity was one of the most important works. In the Acts of the Apostles the disciples of Jesus elected seven of the brothers to specifically give assistance to the widows and the poor. In history, it was the Church who provided medical care and the first hospitals as well as other good works. Today, most parishes have a St Vincent de Paul Conference with members pledging to assist the poor. Our almsgiving should be constant, not just during Lent. We need to build it into our lives so that we are always desiring to meet Christ in the face of the poor.
