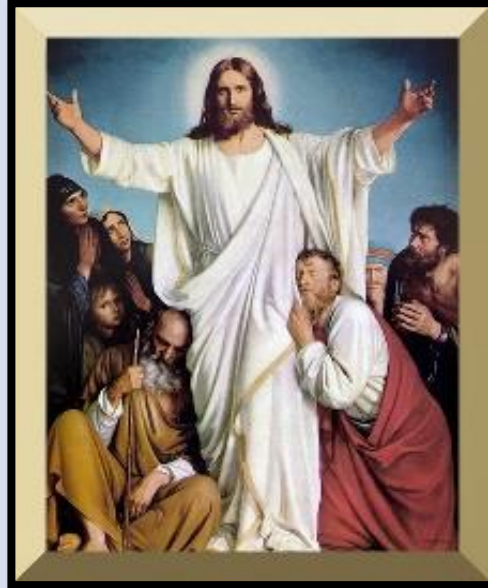

Doxology in the Lord’s Prayer

Did you notice the two versions of the Lord’s Prayer that were used in the funeral services for Queen Elizabeth? The version in Westminster Abbey is the same as we use in our liturgies with the addition of the “For thine is the kingdom.....”. The version used at the Windsor committal is the old form used in traditional Anglican liturgies.

The doxology, which is not scriptural, was an addition taken from what is termed the Paris Bible of the 800’s. A monk penned the doxology in the margin alongside the Lord’s Prayer and then when copied by other monks, the doxology was actually ‘added’ to the scriptural text. Catholics use the doxology, but after an additional prayer.
