Cooma Parish Finance Committee

The Committee met last Tuesday.

Items discussed were

- Earthworks behind church to divert water away from presbytery to minimise termite infestation.
- Tap N' Go contribution raised to \$15 – The



tap machine will see a new tap donation set to \$15/ tap from 12th December.

This will see the amount of \$10.50 to the 2nd collection and \$4.50 to the 1st collection (30%).

The Committee felt that the contribution to the Priests' was a fairer amount than previously, the Parish would also be receiving increase recognising the needs of the Parish.

The Committee expressed its thanks to all our contributors – envelopes, Tap N' Go and loose monies.

- Financial Reports were tabled and discussed. New Budget to be prepared 2022. A Report to Parishioners is being prepared.
- Priest's require a New oven for Presbytery
- Repairs and painting of timber work at front of Presbytery. Quotes being sought.
- It was discussed to pursue the development of land below presbytery for building of residential units. The Committee are seeking interest from parishioners for anyone interested in joining a **sub-committee to assist with development feasibility. Everyone will be welcomed.**
