**That the world might grow in compassion**

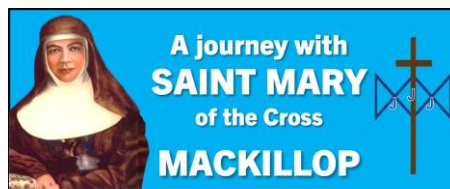


Let us pray that each one of us might find consolation in a personal relationship with Jesus, and from his Heart, learn to have compassion on the world.

# Prayer of the Faithful

**Lord, hear our prayer**



**Priest:** We have just professed, in the words of the Creed, that we believe in the Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Now as Christians we make our prayer to our loving Father through the Lord Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit.
