**Pope Francis on discernment**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

My recent Apostolic Journey to Bahrain was  
occasioned by the international Forum for  
Dialogue, which brought together leaders of  
different religions in the service of peace.  
Dialogue is in fact “the oxygen of peace”,  
opening minds and hearts to encounter and  
breaking down the walls of violence and division.  
In our world, torn by war and conflict, religious  
and civil leaders, and all persons of good will,  
are challenged to look beyond narrow interests  
and to seek the unity and peace of the entire  
human family. My visit to Bahrain, a  
predominantly Muslim country, was yet another  
step in the promising journey of dialogue,  
encounter and fraternal cooperation between  
Christians and Muslims. In those days, I was  
also able to join Christian leaders in a choral  
prayer for peace and to celebrate Holy Mass  
with the Catholic community of Bahrain and the  
greater Gulf region. May the prayers of Our Lady  
of Arabia confirm them in their joyful witness of  
faith and help all believers to persevere on the  
path to peace, understanding and fraternal  
coexistence.
