### **Reflection – Week 28 Ordinary Time**

#### ***DID YOU KNOW?***

Jesus is again quoting from the Torah or Law, this time the 10 Commandments (see Ex 20:7–17, Deut 5:11–21) also known as the Decalogue. The Commandments are a blueprint for how Israel must live in righteousness in order to be God's people.
