As the Covid-19 pandemic continues to affect our lives, the Australian Catholic bishops inviting us to join to entrust the country to the care of Mary, Help of Christians, on her feast day, May 24. Mary Help of Christians has been the official patroness of Australia since 1844. Please join the Entrustment Prayer during our 10am Mass this Sunday (online).

We are in Marian month. Since the Middle-Ages, the Church has devoted the month of May to Mary. In May, there are also three Marian feasts celebrated which help us to understand what Mary can teach us about being disciples.

On May 13, we commemorate the Memorial of Our Lady of Fatima which recalls the appearance of the Blessed Virgin to three young children in Portugal in 1917.

The Feast of Our Lady, Help of Christians, which is celebrated on May 24, dates back to the sixteenth century. The third Marian feast for May is the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin on May 31.

With maternal love for us, Mary wants what is best for us she wants Jesus for us, so she urges us, "Do whatever he tells you" (John 2:5). Then she helps us as we lead others to know and love her Son too. Her feasts not only empower us to turn to her in prayer, but also to love Jesus and others with a greater love.

In this current time of crisis let us take steps to revive and deepen our spiritual life. Also I invite you to send me, if you can, the stories of your faith Journey during this lockdown.

In the month of May, especially, I recommend to pray the Rosary, if possible as a family, seeking Our Lady's powerful intercession for all our needs. If you wish to attend weekday Mass (only 10 people at a time) please book through the office.
