**Reflection - 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday Easter.**



This gospel is one of transformation. The fear of the  
disciples is transformed by the gift of peace and the  
doubt of Thomas is transformed by his encounter with  
the risen Jesus. With this transformation, however,  
comes responsibility. The disciples are not to simply  
bask in the joy of Christ risen but are sent to continue  
the mission of Jesus in the world: 'As the Father sent  
me, so I am sending you.'

When Thomas is told by his companions that they  
have seen Jesus, he places his own conditions on  
faith. He will not believe unless he sees. Jesus must  
fulfil the expectation that Thomas has. The following  
week, he is forced to confront this and is brought to  
realise the pointlessness of imposing conditions on  
God. Only then can he see that God's ways are often  
surprising. Only after accepting this truth does  
Thomas come to understand what faith really is.

**DID YOU KNOW?**

The period from Easter Sunday to Pentecost is known  
as the Great Fifty Days and is an integral part of the  
Lent-Easter- Pentecost cycle.

There is an ancient tradition that Thomas preached  
the gospel as far east as India.

In Aramaic, the language spoken by Jesus, the name  
of Thomas means 'twin'. (The Summit)
