Baptism Enrolment Information.

1. **Book date for Baptism, through the Office.**
Baptisms-2nd Sunday of the Month 11.30 / 12.30, (or at a weekend Mass upon request.)
2. **Attend Enrolment Night.** (Complete form, Names, Godparents, Religion etc.)
3rd Wed. of the month. 7.30pm Parish Meeting Room, Wade St.
**On the night you will need the correct spelling of all names/ & Godparents also their Religion for completion of forms.*
3. **Baby Presentation** (for welcome and blessing). Attend a Mass, prior to Baptism.
****You will need to pick a time and date at the Enrolment night.***
(4th Weekend of the month) Mass Times:

St Mary's	9.00am
Binda (1st 2nd 3rd Sun)	10.30am
Tuena (5th Sunday)	11.30am

Please sit at the front of the church for the Presentation.
4. **Baptism Mass/ Service.** Please arrive 10 minutes before commencing time.
Sit at the front of the Church, *don't forget your candle.*

Babies who are to be Baptised, and not living in Crookwell district please note:

Need a letter from your Parish Priest, (as a courtesy) and you may join in with their Baptism Preparation.

I will send you a form, please complete and return with your letter from the Priest, for the enrolment to be confirmed.

Godparents: You must have at least 1 Catholic Godparent, who has been confirmed and is over the age of 16. You may have others- they are listed as Christian Witnesses. They have to be Baptised in a Christian Church.

****The Godparent -Please provide a copy of your Baptism Certificate, to be bought along on the enrolment night. If they do not have a copy, contact the parish secretary for one please.**

Candles: You will need to supply a candle.

Cover the end please, so wax can't drip on the floor. (In a container would be suitable.) Suitable Candles are available on the enrolment night and from the Parish office for \$8.

Marriage: If you have not been married in a Catholic Church, your Marriage is not considered Sacramental, and therefore considered as "irregular" in the Church's understanding of Marriage. Such a marriage on your part may have been an oversight, lack of understanding. If you would like to be able to "fix this up" or know more about this, please talk to Fr McDermott privately. You can make an appointment through the Parish office.
