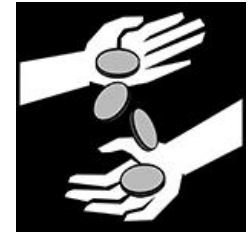

#### ***DID YOU KNOW?***

Jesus is again quoting  
from the Torah or  
Law, this time the 10  
Commandments (see

as the Decalogue. The Commandments are  
a blueprint for how Israel must live in  
righteousness in order to be God's people.
