#### ST VINCENT DE PAUL WINTER APPEAL

The Winter Appeal is one of the initiatives the Society uses to raise funds to cover the cost of its assistance programmes. To this end, a retiring collection will be held after each Mass on the weekend of the 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup> of July. Funds will be used to help finance food hampers and other warm essentials for households struggling to make ends meet.

Between March 1<sup>st</sup> and June 24<sup>th</sup> the local Conference continued to experience significant demand for its services with our records showing 502 adults and 360 children receiving assistance from the local Conference. ### Reflection:

13 Sunday Ord. Time

A very central theme in Luke's writings is that of journey. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus' journey to

Jerusalem is the vehicle for his preaching and for the formation of the disciples in what it means to be a follower of Christ.

• Luke's second volume is The Acts of the Apostles. In this book, the journey continues with the message of Jesus being taken by the church outward from Jerusalem to the ends of the earth.

Today's Gospel marks a turning point in Luke's story of Jesus. He has made a momentous decision. When he is rejected by the very first village he approaches, the disciples want to punish them. But Jesus refuses violence and coercion as a means of conversion. He wants willing disciples! The following three brief exchanges outline what is needed for discipleship: it won't necessarily be comfortable; there is a sense of urgency, and it requires single-mindedness and sometimes difficult choices. Comfort or family relationships cannot take priority over the kingdom of God, and once one becomes a follower of Christ, there can be no turning back. This gospel is not only about Jesus; it is about all those who seek to follow the road God has laid out for them.

What are the things you have had to turn your back on to continue on this journey? Are there still hurdles to overcome?

*O God, you chose us to be children of light. Grant that we may not be wrapped in the error of darkness but always stand in the light of truth. (The Summit)*
