Archdiocesan Protocols RE: The CoronaVirus (COVID-19)

The Archdiocese has received advice from medical
experts that we should employ best practice and be
prudent in trying to help reduce the transmission of
the CoronaVirus (COVID-19).

Upon reception of this letter, all communities,
parishes, schools, hospitals, etc. are asked to observe
the following protocols until further notice:

- Remove Holy Water from fonts.
- Ask the faithful to acknowledge each other at the
sign of peace, but refrain from touching.
- Priests, Deacons, Acolytes and Extraordinary
Ministers of Holy Communion to use hand sanitiser
before distributing Holy Communion and after
distributing Holy Communion at Mass, Liturgy of
the Word's with Holy Communion, Visits to the sick
in Hospital and Home.
- Instruct the faithful that Holy Communion should
be received only in the hand, not on the tongue.
- Distribute the Sacred Host only and not the
Precious Blood.

The Pilgrimage of the Relics of St Therese and her parent's (8.00pm 25 – 12 Noon 26 March at SPP)

The word relic comes from the Latin relinquo, literally meaning 'I leave' or 'I abandon'. A relic is a piece of the body of a Saint, an item owned or used by the Saint, or an object which has been touched to the tomb of a Saint. Traditionally, a piece of the body of a Saint, especially that of a Martyr, may be with the permission of the local ecclesiastical authority used in solemn processions recalling the specific holy person.

Come and venerate the relics. Pray and experience the saints. You will experience God and perhaps your life will change. As with a sacred site or souvenir, you can, through the saint, experience and connect with the holiness of God.
