**PRAYER** "In the face of so many wounds that hurt us and could lead to a hardness of heart, we are called to dive into the sea of prayer, which is the sea of the boundless love of God, in order to experience his tenderness." Christians are called to think of the needs of others, "interceding before God for the many situations of poverty and suffering" in the world.

**FASTING** isn't just to follow the rules for Lenten fasting and abstinence, because that could lead to self-satisfaction. "Fasting makes sense if it really chips away at our security and, as a consequence, benefits someone else, if it helps us cultivate the style of the good Samaritan, who bent down to his brother in need and took care of him." "It is a sign of becoming aware of and taking responsibility for injustice and oppression, especially of the poor and the least, and is a sign of the trust we place in God and his providence."

ALMSGIVING is a practice that should be common among all Christians, but especially during Lent. Christians give concrete help and attention to those in need -- asking nothing in return -because they recognize how much God has given them even though they were not deserving. Almsgiving also helps free people from "the obsession of possession, from the fear of losing what they have and from the sadness of not sharing their wellbeing with others" **Pope Francis**
