If you do have a current WWCC, please ensure Cath at the Parish office has your WWCC numbers asap.

Your date of birth will also be required.

(Just google Working with Children Check NSW).

IN ADDITION - All Parish volunteers, regardless of whether they work with children, are to read the Archdiocesan Child Protection Code of Conduct, then sign and return the acknowledgment form.

This should be done as soon as possible.

CASE WORKER WANTED FOR RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION CENTRE

Case worker required for an exciting new role to help in the development of a Therapeutic Community for women located at Galong. The role will initially involve approximately four hours face to face case management per week. **Contract rate:** Negotiable subject to qualifications and experience - contract role.

Hours: We require a case worker to provide case management to women recovering from addiction. Some flexibility in hours worked is possible. Approximately 2 days per week, and one overnight stay plus one on one case management sessions (commencing at one per week per client).

The role would suit members of the following professions: AOD counsellor; certified practising case manager; credentialed mental health nurse; occupational therapist; nurse practitioner; psychologist or social worker.
