## CATHOLIC DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS-YOUNG MISSION RE: THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

*(Latest protocols for NSW parishes, effective FRI. 23 OCT 20)*

Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/  
Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be  
celebrated respecting the 4sqm per person rule **(300 people  
maximum for Masses only), inside or outside** excluding  
clergy and liturgical ministries.

You need to record your name and number in the register  
provided. This way we will have a contact if a health risk is  
posed within our community in relation to COVID-19.

Communion in the hand only.

Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered.

No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes  
placed at BACK OF THE CHURCH (Before or after Mass).
