CATHOLIC DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS-YOUNG MISSION RE: THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

(Latest protocols for NSW parishes, effective FRI. 23 OCT 20)

Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/
Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be
celebrated respecting the 4sqm per person rule **(300 people
maximum for Masses only), inside or outside** excluding
clergy and liturgical ministries.

You need to **record your name and number in the register
provided.** This way we will have a contact if a health risk is
posed within our community in relation to COVID-19.

Communion in the hand only.

Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered.

No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes
placed at **BACK OF THE CHURCH** (Before or after Mass).

CURRENT MASS ARRANGEMENTS

It is wonderful that mass is again being celebrated at
St Joseph's Church, and we can now all attend each week
with the 4sqm/person rule (100 people limit). As we need to
adhere to government regulations, please sanitise your hands
when entering the church, remember to social distance in
your seating and the pews must be disinfected after each mass
as well. Those who have restrictions from their Doctor are not
to attend mass, but you are invited to ring and leave your
name and number at Young office (on 6382-2222) and either
Fr Jiss or Fr Joe will visit you at a time that suits you best.
