## CATHOLIC DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS-YOUNG MISSION RE: THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be celebrated respecting the 2sqm per person rule (**200 people maximum for Masses only**), inside excluding clergy and liturgical ministries.

**Families can sit together, but in relation to other persons/families apply 2m<sup>2</sup> rule.**

You need to record your name and number in the register provided. This way we will have a contact if a health risk is posed within our community in relation to COVID-19.

Communion in the hand only.  
Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered.  
No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes placed at BACK OF THE CHURCH (Before or after Mass).
