SACRAMENTAL NEWS FROM ST JOSEPH'S CATHOLIC CHURCH

This year, St Joseph's Parish will be celebrating the Sacraments of Reconciliation. First Holv Communion and Confirmation.

The meetings for the Confirmation candidates will begin on Tuesday the 4th of May at 6-00pm in the St Joseph's School Library. A parent is expected to attend the meetings with their child. This year the meetings will occur each week for four weeks.

CATHOLIC DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS-YOUNG MISSION RE: THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/ Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be celebrated respecting the 2sqm per person rule (200 people maximum for Masses only), inside excluding clergy and liturgical ministries.

Communion in the hand only. Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered. No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes placed at BACK OF THE CHURCH (Before or after Mass).
