Sydney Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP ordained Fr Daniel Drum and Fr Stephen Drum, who are members of the Verbum Dei missionary order.

"It's a real blessing for me having my brother alongside me. The whole journey actually has been really wonderful," Fr Daniel Drum said.

Nola Drum, the proud mother of nine, six of whom are boys, said she had always hoped for a priest in the family.

The new priests have a sister who is also a Sister – Rosie Drum is a member of the Missionaries Of God's Love.

CATHOLIC DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS-YOUNG MISSION RE: THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be celebrated respecting the 2sqm per person rule (200 people maximum for Masses only), inside excluding clergy and liturgical ministries.

Communion in the hand only.
Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered.
No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes placed at BACK OF THE CHURCH (Before or after Mass).
