LATEST Archdiocesan Protocols COVID-19 Safety Plan (NSW Parishes - Effective Monday 28 June 2021)

Masses, Weddings, Liturgies, Gatherings

- Masks are mandatory for those 12 years +
- Priest (when celebrating Liturgy) and Lectors (when proclaiming the Word) can dispense with the mask.
- **Priest and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy** Communion must wear masks when distributing the Sacred Host.
- No congregational singing, but a cantor (x4) can sing if  $4m^2$  from congregation.
- 15. Holy Communion only under the species of bread.
  - Holy Communion to be received only in the hand. |
- No touching at the sign of peace.
- Collection bags not to be passed around, but can be placed on an extended stick to allow collection of cash by a few parishioners.
- 19. Apply the  $4m^2$  rule to all liturgies and gatherings. (except funerals)
