### SUNDAY COLLECTIONS

The following information is designed to clarify our Sunday collections for parishioners. In future we will separate the two collections to make it easier to know which is which.

The **first collection** will occur **before the Offertory** and the **second collection** after Communion.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Collection (Red bag):

This money is used to support the salary of priests of the Archdiocese and is banked in the Archdiocesan account, then distributed to the priests. Money collected from Grenfell is credited towards our parish priest.

Currently the amount collected throughout the Young Mission (Young, Boorowa, Grenfell) is not sufficient to support 2 priests.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Collection (Green bag):

This money is used to support the parish through maintenance of the church, purchase of necessary items for the parish, utilities such as electricity and water, rates, administration costs including the salary of our secretary in Young, car and phone costs for the priest and supply of another priest when necessary.

The most significant cost paid from the second collection is insurance of the church.

We encourage parishioners to continue to give to both collections to ensure the future of our parish.
