SUNDAY COLLECTIONS

The following information is designed to clarify our Sunday collections for parishioners.

In future we will separate the two collections to make it easier to know which is which.

The first collection will occur before the Offertory and the second collection after Communion.

1st Collection (*Red bag*):

This money is used to support the salary of priests of the Archdiocese and is banked in the Archdiocesan account, then distributed to the priests. Money collected from Grenfell is credited towards

Currently the amount collected throughout the Young Mission (Young, Boorowa, Grenfell) is not sufficient to support 2 priests.


2nd Collection (Green bag):
