sizzle and children's activities.

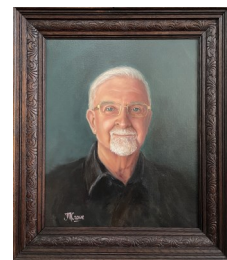
